INDONESIA – CG4 – EFFECTIVENESS EVALUATION AND MONITORING – 27 NOV 2024

Indonesia's proposals:

Para. 1:

The Conference of the Parties shall periodically evaluate the effectiveness of the Convention[, in a comprehensive, facilitative, and transparent manner].

Para. 4:

The evaluation shall be conducted on the basis of available scientific, environmental, technical, financial, and [**socio-]**economic information[, **which may include]**:

- (a) Any National Plans submitted by Parties;
- (b) National reporting pursuant to Article 15;
- (c) Reports and other information provided to the Conference of the Parties pursuant to paragraph 2; (need clarification from what type of reports and where should these information come from)
- (d) Best available scientific and technical knowledge;
- (e) Information and recommendations provided by the Implementation and Compliance Committee referred to in Article 13;
- (f) Relevant information and recommendations provided by any subsidiary body established by the Conference of the Parties and relevant reports from multilateral environmental agreements and multilateral intergovernmental organizations [such as International Labour Organization, International Maritime Organization, World Customs Organization, World Health Organization, and World Trade Organization]; and
- (g) Other information the Conference of the Parties deems relevant.
