

Plenary Statement 3

Chair, thank you for your work.

I align with the statements by Colombia and Chile.

We cannot take this text as the basis for negotiation. You must provide something new.

Our red lines - and the red lines of the majority here - have not just been crossed; they have been stomped, spat on, and burned. We cannot ignore the full life cycle of plastics.

We have 30 hours to prove we are here to lead - not to manage collapse. Move immediately to an HOD+1 format. This is not a landing zone; it's a crash site.

This is simply Repulsive. This is not ambition - it is surrender.

Panama will not be remembered as the delegation that gave in when the planet needed us to stand.

This is not about "closing" a treaty at any cost. It is about closing the wound we are leaving open in our people's lungs, in our rivers and oceans, and in our shared future.

This text does not heal the wound - it makes it fatal.

Bring production back. Bring mandatory reporting back.

Bring science and justice back.

This is a sell-out text, and we will not sell out our children's future.
