

Article 9 - Existing Plastic Pollution[Delivered by the Gambia on 7 August]

Thank you Co-Facilitator, on behalf of the African Group of Negotiators we would like to propose the following amendments. For the **chapeau of paragraph 1**, we support stronger language by replacing should with shall, as this article is a critical issue where plastic pollution affects the African region significantly.

For paragraph 1 (b), we have some amendments

- 1. After "removal", we would like to add "remediation" Remediation includes removal where necessary but also encompasses efforts to restore ecological integrity and aligns with established environmental standards.
- 2. After "accumulation zones", we would like to add "taking into account the special circumstances of Least Developed Countries and other developing countries experiencing the disproportionate impacts of plastic pollution"

Thank you Mr. Co-Chair,

For 1ter and paragraph 2, the African group would like to add brackets to both references to a remediation mechanism. We would like to kindly remind delegates that discussions on a financial mechanism are not in this contact group, but covered in contact group 3 under Article 11. Thank you
