ARTICLE 14 - NATIONAL IMPLEMENTATION PLANS

1. Each Party may develop and implement a national implementation plan, based upon...

2. A Party may at any time adjust its national implementation plan in order to

3. Parties should, in undertaking work pursuant to paragraphs 1 and 2, consult national stakeholders to facilitate the development, implementation, review and updating of their national <u>implementation</u> plans.

5. The secretariat shall make national <u>implementation</u> plans submitted by Parties under this Article publicly available.

6. The Conference of the Parties may shall adopt guidance regarding implementation of this Article <u>at its</u> first meeting, and may update the guidance as appropriate.
