ARTICLE 7

EMISSIONS AND RELEASES

- 1. Each Party shall take measures to prevent, reduce, manage, and, where possible, eliminate emissions to the atmosphere and releases to soil, water and the marine environment of all pollutants from the full life cycle of plastics, including:
- (a) Chemicals of concern present in plastic products listed in Annex [A], and plastic products listed in Annex [B];
- (b) Plastic pellets, flakes and powder from the supply chain;
- (c) Microplastics during production of plastics
- (d) Macroplastics, microplastics and nano-plastics during the use and disposal of products.
- 2. In implementing its obligation pursuant to paragraph 1, each Party shall take into account, as appropriate, relevant international rules, standards, and guidelines.
- 3. The Conference of the Parties shall, at its first meeting, adopt guidance on standardized data collection, monitoring, and reporting of emissions and releases, and best available techniques and best environmental practices on preventing emissions and releases into the environment, as well as guidance, including, where relevant, on a sectoral basis, to facilitate implementation of the obligations set out in paragraphs 1 and 2 of this article.
