

Article 9 – Existing Plastic Pollution

1. Prefer to use **Existing Plastic Pollution** as it encompasses both recently generated waste and legacy plastics still circulating or mismanaged today.
2. Supports the replacement of "**should**" with "**shall**" in the text, since it reflects a firm commitment and strengthens the obligation of Parties, aligning with Indonesia's dedication to robust and accountable action under varying national circumstances.

Paragraph 1:

3. Para 1(a): Support the additional term "**and in accordance with relevant provisions of international agreement**", in order to foster trust and cooperation in international relations and to ensure that any action taken is traceable to specific provisions in international agreements, promoting transparency and accountability in decision-making. Thank you.
4. Para 1(b):
 - Line1: Support the term of "remediation", and add "**restoration**" after remediation.
 - Line 2: to add **remediation** after removal, to read as: .. *removal, **remediation** and restoration.*

Paragraph 2:

1. Indonesia supports the Bangladesh proposal.
2. Propose slight amendment in para 2, as follow:
 - 2(b) to propose amendment in line 3 concerning the traditional knowledge" to read as: "**the traditional knowledge of Indigenous people and local communities**".
 - 2(c), to replace "**as well as**" with "**and**" to read as: "**engagement of indigenous people and local communities**".

Indonesia strongly endorses the term "**Indigenous Peoples and Local Communities (IPLC)**" in environmental governance to recognize their unique identities, rights, and vital

contributions. Their traditional knowledge and stewardship are indispensable for sustainable environment management.

Paragraph 3:

3. Indonesia supports the Bangladesh proposal.
4. Propose slight amendment as follow:
 - To add “**restoration**” after remediation”, to read as: “...*supporting the allocation of remediation **and restoration** funding based on...*”
