Submission on Article 6 – Sustainable Production

Indonesia respectfully supports the proposal put forward by Japan to amend the title of Article 6 to "Sustainable Consumption and Production," as championed by Indonesia, and with reference to UNEA Resolution 5/14.

Rationale:

This straightforward proposal offers a viable landing zone for all Parties in our collective effort to end plastic pollution, and advocate for measurable and accountable national measures, reported through implementation updates, in accordance with the guidelines endorsed, while fully considering national circumstances and capabilities.

These measures also should fully respect the sovereignty of each Party and support sustainable development, which remains a fundamental right of every nation.

Indonesia emphasizes the importance of balancing the right to development with the right to a clean, healthy, and sustainable environment, ensuring that efforts to combat plastic pollution align with equitable economic growth and environmental protection.

Japan Proposal:

Article 6 SUSTAINABLE CONSUMPTION AND PRODUCTION AND CONSUMPTION

- 1. Parties shall cooperate to promote sustainable consumption and production and consumption of plastics throughout their life cycle.
- 2. Each Party shall take measures across the full lifecycle of plastics for the implementation of paragraph 1 above.
- 3. Each Party shall report available statistical data on its production, imports, exports and consumption of plastics and the measures taken relevant to this Article.
