INC-5.2 Proposal of Japan on ARTICLE 14 NATIONAL PLANS

- 1. Each Party [shall] [may] develop, taking into account respective national circumstances, national plan that contains actions and measures the Party intends to take to implement this Convention. Each Party [shall] [may] develop, taking into account respective national circumstances, a national plan that contains actions and measures the Party intends to take to implement this Convention. The plan shall be transmitted to the Conference of the Parties through the Secretariat within [X] years after the entry into force of the Convention for that Party.
- 2. Each Party shall update its national plan, [taking into account the outcome of effectiveness evaluation referred to in Article 16 among others,] to enhance its actions based on the guidelines referred to in paragraph 6.
- 3. The extent to which developing country Parties will effectively implement their national plans will depend on the effective implementation of the provisions related to means of implementation as referred to in Article 11 of this Convention.
- 4. Each Party shall, as appropriate, in undertaking work pursuant to paragraphs 1 and 2 above, consult national stakeholders to facilitate the development, implementation, and updating of their national plans.
- 5. The Secretariat shall make national plans submitted by Parties pursuant to this Article publicly available.
- 6. The Conference of the Parties shall, at its first meeting, adopt the modalities and guidelines for national plans and other guidance regarding implementation of this Article.
