

Art. 17 information exchange Norway submission

1 bis. Parties should take legal, administrative or policy measures to encourage and enable business, and in particular to ensure that large and transnational companies and financial institutions:

(a) Regularly monitor, assess, and transparently disclose their risks, opportunities, dependencies and impacts on the full life cycle of plastics, including with requirements for all large as well as transnational companies and financial institutions along their operations, supply and value chains, and portfolios;

(b) Provide information needed to consumers to promote sustainable consumption patterns;

(c) Report on compliance with relevant regulations and measures, as applicable; in order to progressively reduce negative impacts on the environment and human health, increase positive impacts, reduce plastic pollution-related risks to business and financial institutions, and promote actions to ensure sustainable patterns of production.
