Article 23bis RELATIONSHIP WITH OTHER AGREEMENTS

ADD [TAKEN FROM PP6 &PP8]: The Parties recognize the mutual supportiveness between this Convention and other international agreements, including in the fields of health, trade and environment, acknowledging that such recognition does not imply the establishment of a hierarchy between this Convention and other international agreements.

PROPOSED REFORMULATION PARA 1 [ALSO TAKING FROM PP7]: Nothing in this Convention/Instrument shall be interpreted as altering or affecting the rights and obligations of Parties under other international agreements, including those involving trade, health or the environment, to which they are Parties.

ADD [TAKEN FROM PP8bis]: Nothing in this Convention shall be construed as diminishing or extinguishing the distinct status, identities, and interests rights of Indigenous Peoples under international law.
