UK Proposal on Article 14 – National Plans

Article 14 – National Plans

- 1. Each Party shall develop and implement a national plan, to describe the measures it intends to take, to implement its obligations under this Convention. Any such plan shall be transmitted to the Conference of the Parties through the Secretariat as soon as it has been developed.
- 2. A Party may at any time adjust its national plan in order to enhance its level of ambition.
- 3. Each Party shall include information on the implementation of its national plan towards achieving the objective of the convention, in its national reports pursuant to [reporting on progress].
- 4. Parties should, in undertaking work pursuant to paragraphs 1 and 2, consult national stakeholders to facilitate the development, implementation, review and updating of their national implementation plans
- 5. Parties are encouraged to collaborate and coordinate on the development and implementation of subregional and regional plans to facilitate implementation of this Convention, as appropriate.
- 6. The secretariat shall make national plans submitted by Parties under this Article publicly available.
- 7. The Conference of the Parties shall adopt guidance regarding implementation of this Article and may update the guidance as appropriate. Each Party's national plan shall be based on the guidelines adopted by the Conference of the Parties and shall include but not be limited to elements and related to....
