## INC-5.2 Proposal of the United States of America

## **Article 14 National Plans (REVISED)**

- 1. Each Party [shall] [may] develop, taking into account respective national circumstances, a national plan that contains actions and measures the Party Convention. Each Party [shall] [may] develop, intends to take to implement this taking into account respective national circumstances, a national plan that contains actions and measures the Party intends to take to implement this Convention. The plan shall be transmitted to the Conference of the Parties through the Secretariat within [X] 2 years after the entry into force of the Convention for that Party.
- 2. Each Party **may** shall update its national plan, **including** to enhance its actions based on the guidelines referred to in paragraph 6.

- 4. The extent to which developing country Parties will effectively implement their national plans will depend on the effective implementation of the provisions related to means of implementation as referred to in Article 11 of this Convention.
- 5. Each Party **may** shall, as appropriate, in undertaking work pursuant to paragraphs 1 and 2 above, consult national stakeholders to facilitate the development, implementation, and updating of their national plans.
