Plastic Product Design Performance

- [1. Each Party is encouraged to shall take measures:
- (a) To promote enhanced design and performance of plastic products, as well as transparency, including with respect to their chemical composition, taking into account relevant international standards and guidelines, including sector- or product-specific standards and guidelines, in order to reduce the use of primary plastic polymers and associated chemicals of concern in plastic products; and increase the safety and durability of plastics products, and the ability to reuse, repair, recycle them; and to dispose of them in an safe and environmentally sound manner upon their becoming waste.
- (b) To foster research, innovation, development and use of sustainable alternatives and non-plastic substitutes, including products, technologies and services, taking into account the best available science, knowledge of Indigenous Peoples, traditional knowledge, knowledge of Indigenous Peoples and local knowledge systems and their potential for waste reduction and reuse, as well as their environmental, socio economic, and human health impacts across their life cycle.
- 2. The Conference of the Parties shall may adopt, at its first meeting, guidance to assist Parties in their implementation of paragraph 1 of this Article. The Conference of the Parties shall keep under review, and update as appropriate, the guidance developed pursuant to this paragraph.]
